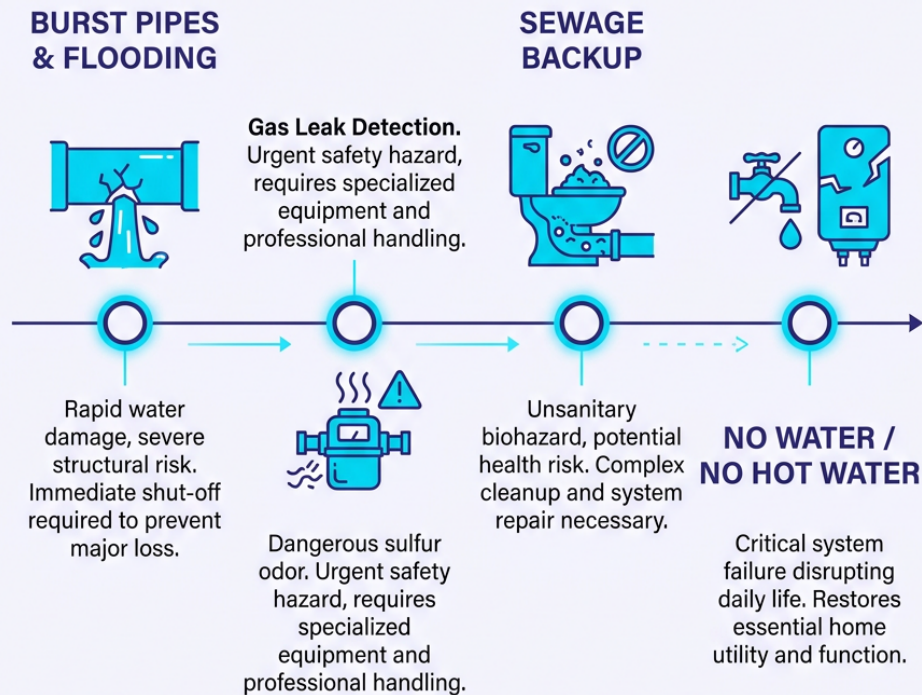
Our ETA protocol calculates travel time and technician availability in real time. Homes in Boyle Heights or Historic South-Central benefit from the same precision routing: we don't send the farthest truck available; we send the closest qualified technician currently staged in the dispatch queue. This focused workflow keeps your base dispatch cost lean. The routing efficiency compounds when multiple calls stack in the same neighborhood—our dispatch software sequences appointments to avoid backtracking, which saves cost that would otherwise transfer to you.

## **How Technician Availability Windows Reshape the Charge Structure?**

Your service fee also depends on our availability window at dispatch time. During business hours, a standard call triggers a lower base fee because technicians are already mobile and positioned. Call during the evening or weekend, and the same diagnostic work carries a higher dispatch premium because the mobilization steps require pulling a technician from off-hours status or routing from a greater distance. This is why emergency after-hours calls often cost 50–100% more: the dispatch sequence itself is more complex and resource-intensive.

## Why Simultaneous Dispatch Protocols Vary Your Final Invoice?

When multiple emergency calls come in during peak times, our dispatch workflow must prioritize severe emergencies, which may adjust ETA for lower-urgency calls. A slab leak detection call might carry a standard dispatch fee, but a main line rupture floods the household immediately—our routing sequence prioritizes the rupture, which means your slab leak appointment may be queued for the next available technician slot. This coordination is part of the dispatch procedure that keeps our per-visit pricing fair: you're never charged extra for normal queueing, but you benefit from our ability to mobilize multiple trucks if your situation is critical.

Same-day dispatch efficiency also depends on the type of work. Drain cleaning (\$150–\$400) and faucet replacement (\$150–\$350) are routable jobs that our dispatch team assigns quickly.
